



Congressman John Culberson (TX-07) Biography

A fifth generation Texan and a third generation Houstonian, John Culberson has represented the Seventh District since 2000.

As Chairman of the Commerce, Justice, Science (CJS) Subcommittee in the U.S. House, John has used his experience to ensure Houstonians get the funding and relief they need after Hurricane Harvey, and was instrumental in helping to secure the \$141 billion total in relief funding. John has a long history of prioritizing flood mitigation. On a federal level, he's been securing funds to address needs in Harris County since 2002.

As a long-time space-enthusiast and NASA advocate, another one of John's top priorities is to see NASA propel above and beyond the glory days of Apollo to ensure that America remains the world-leader in space exploration. He's also laser focused on ensuring that law enforcement has the resources to protect our communities, fight human and drug trafficking, and end the opioid crisis. Since taking over as Chairman of CJS, he has increased anti-human trafficking grants by 82 percent. Last year, his CJS bill had \$484.5 million to address violence against women, the highest funding level ever.
